The Mount Washington Valley Housing Coalition (MWVHC) is at the forefront of this effort, and in 2024, we achieved significant milestones that highlight our commitment to this cause:

- Affordable Housing Design Charrette, focused on county-owned land in Ossipee, saw over 250 citizens and elected officials engaged in the housing solution process over three days. Generated ideas that may be considered in Ossipee, but also other MWV towns, including how a cluster housing development can add to the tax base in a positive way as well increase homeownership opportunities for our workers.
- Advocated for two warrant articles, which passed in Conway, one expanding a homeowners' ability to add accessory dwelling units (ADUs) to their property, increasing long-term rental housing opportunities; the other to provide a tax incentive promoting affordable housing development.
- Educational workshops helping community members understand the use of credit and budgeting for financial success. Offered in person and on line, we reached over 700 participants, underscoring the need for financial education and helping those facing housing challenges in our area.
- Collaboration with local organizations such as MWV Chamber of Commerce, Ossipee United Round Table, Gibson Center for Senior Services, MWV Economic Council, and town planning and zoning boards looking for feedback regarding housing initiatives to bring to voters.

These are just a few of the achievements that reflect our ongoing dedication to fostering housing solutions that benefit the community.

Your membership empowers us to continue this vital work; hosting forums and events that inspire action and building connections with experts and stakeholders in housing, all of which are critical to our success.
