- Seat at the table on the *Governor's Council for Housing Stability*.
- Advocated for the \$100 million [Invest NH](#) fund.
- Advocated for varied access to state funding for projects that maintain our rural character
- Advocated for various multi family developments in MWV to help with long term rental shortage.
- Lead forums, sharing important resources with valley citizens, elected officials and builders:
